The Zanesville Museum of Art will

- 1. <u>Develop</u> a nationally recognized American art pottery collection that reflects the rich history of the region and the diversity of its people.
- 2. <u>Offer</u> an inclusive, interactive, and fun experience for people of all ages to develop a deeper appreciation of the role that art plays in their lives.
- 3. <u>Partner</u> with other organizations, artists, educators, and community leaders who share in the mission of growing and enhancing the region.
- 4. **Serve** as a community gathering place for the region, offering educational and artistic opportunities that bring together people from all walks of life.
- 5. <u>Strengthen</u> its financial position to support the museum's guiding principles and ensure its long-term success.
